





Olive Branch International with students from Texas Tech medical school who worked with the mission from June 12 through June 19. During that time they visited 8 communities in the department of Jinotega and held two medical clinics in Jinotega. Over 4,000 people were seen during this week. Dr Patterson and seven of the medical stayed till the 24th helping with Community Health Promoter training, working with public health training of parents from four pre-schools and some worked in the health center.



The group from Summerville arrived on June 24 and departed on July 10. During their time here they made blocks, conducted VBS at mission churches in the area and started a new school and a house in the community of San Gorgorio, which is close to Yankea north of Jinotega.
